Come join us to ride some of the best and most challenging roads of the Texas Hill Country during Bluebonnet Season. You ABC'ers can also get those hard to find Z and U Counties as well as several other hard to find Points.

We will leave from the Cracker Barrel at I'35w and Alsbury Road in Burleson sharply at 8:00 AM, Friday, April 20, 2007, returning Sunday. In the springtime there is a possibility of a **weather-related cancellation**. If so, It will be posted on the **Chapter Hotline before 4pm Thursday**. Maps will be available for all riders on our web site.

The route down Friday will be part freeway (for better time) and part back roads (for smelling the roses or "Bluebonnets"). We will wind our way around the infamous "Willow City Loop" and visit the town of Luckenbock, famed by "Willie, Waylon, and the Boys". We will stay the nights in Kerrville. An early 7:00 AM exhilarating Saturday morning ride down TX 16 for breakfast at the OST restaurant in Bandera, a favorite of the great "Duke" Wayne during movie shoots will start an exciting full day of riding the winding, twisting-turning hill laden roads of the Texas Hill Country. We will try to do all of the infamous "Twisted Sisters" (FM 335-336-337). FM 337 is the kinkiest sister.

Everyone can find their way home on Sunday at whatever time and routes they decide. Several options are available.
